

# SLGain Manual

Thank you for purchasing SLGain.

## Installation:

To use it, you need to be using a DAW that accepts VST2 and/or VST3 plugins. Typically, you want to copy the files to these folders:

*SLGain\_free VST2 x86:*

C:\Program Files (x86)\VSTPlugins\Dynamics

*SLGain\_free VST2 x64:*

C:\Program Files (x64)\VSTPlugins\Dynamics

*SLGain\_free VST3 x86:*

C:\Program Files (x86)\Common Files\VST3

*SLGain\_free VST3 x64:*

C:\Program Files (x64)\Common Files\VST3

## The Plugin

SLGain is a gain/volume knob with the goal of being both simple and versatile at the same time. It has three main parameters:

- 1. gain control:** the amount of boost or attenuation applied to the original signal, in dB.
- 2. minimum gain:** the minimum value the gain control can reach, in dB. By default this is -12dB, but can be changed to any value between -96dB and -6dB.
- 3. maximum gain:** the maximum value the gain control can reach, in dB. By default this is +12dB, but can be changed to any value between +6dB and +48dB.

**To change controls 2 and 3, simply click them and enter a new value manually;** or click and drag the dotted area.

To add another layer of flexibility, all of parameters can be automated.
